1. From the Main Menu, select a Question Deck to begin.

3. Read and answer the question.
4. Click “See Answer” to reveal the correct answer.
5. Click “Select a Question” to return to the deck and select another question.
6. Continue answering questions from any of the provided Question Decks.



Keyboarding Trivia is a fun and interactive way for students to memorize and reinforce their knowledge of the keys of the QWERTY keyboard.

Tips for playing:

- Ensure your students do not have access to their keyboards or any visuals depicting the QWERTY keyboard (posters, wall charts, mobile devices, etc.).
- Project your screen to the class as you display this file.
- Gameplay options: Divide your class into teams to make the game a friendly competition or use the trivia questions as flash cards for review. Consider playing “speed rounds” by using a timer and offering “prizes” as incentives.
- It is recommended that you use the interactive buttons shown on each screen as you navigate the questions, rather than the arrow keys on your keyboard.
